TEAM MATCHES START IN SEPTEMBER

It's not too early to put together your team for DWGA Team Matches! Team matches this year are scheduled for five consecutive Saturdays beginning on September 8, 2007 for the Northern Division and Tuesday, September 11, 2007 for the Southern Division.

Your team needs a minimum of eight players each week. All team members must be members of DWGA. Each team will play other teams both at home and away, depending upon how many teams we have. Points are awarded on the basis of match play and accumulated throughout the five weeks. At the end of that time, a net and gross winner will be announced for each Division.

We are attempting to have a Southern and Northern Division this year, but need a minimum of four teams in each division to do so. If we are able to put together two divisions, there will be a playoff on Saturday, October 13th.

Let's give the reigning champs Chesapeake Bay (Gross) and Three Little Bakers (Net) a challenge this year. For more information, call

Rules & Guidelines

- Handicaps as of 9/1 (or the closest update to 9/1) will be used for all matches.
- Four 2-women teams will represent a club in each match.
- Players must be in order of handicaps, with the two lowest handicaps being Team 1, two highest handicaps Team 4.
- Club rosters and payment must be received by DWGA no later than the draw date (date to be determined). Entry fee is \$80 per team. No additions may be made to the roster after September 1st.
- 80% of course handicap will be used for the net portion of the competition. Players will play off the low ball of the foursome, playing better ball of partners.
- Each hole is 1 point net, 1 point gross. A team receives 1 point for winning a hole, zero points for a loss, and ½ point for a tie.
- Your lineup may change from one match to another.
- If an emergency substitution must be made, please make every effort to substitute a player that will fit into the same part of the lineup, thus avoiding 'shuffling' players around and causing a lot of changes administratively.
- Email/fax/call in your lineup (8 players) for an upcoming match by Friday, 6:00 p.m. in the South and Tuesday, 6:00 p.m. in the North. (302-234-3365 / dwga@dwga.org) Captains will receive handicaps and NO changes are acceptable unless approved by Jen O'Brien. Team captains will then prepare all score cards for the day.
- Both team captains must email/fax/call in results at completion of play that day (302-234-3365 / dwga@dwga.org)
- Carts are mandatory.
- Course Closures Due To Weather: If a course is or becomes closed due to weather, the matches to be played on that course are a draw, or at agreement of both captains, can be played on the next day.
- Closures: If a course is not available for any reason other than weather, the teams scheduled to play there must play at the other course. Otherwise, the team whose course is closed must forfeit their match.
- The captain may or may not be a player.
- There will be a gross champion as well as a net champion. A team cannot win both.
- If a team cannot fill the lineup with 4 twosomes, the captain may designate positions of the players who are present, and allow a single team member to play against her opponents without a partner. However, players must still be in handicap order.
- * If there are North and South divisions, there will be a playoff for the titles (both gross and net), no later than Saturday, October 20, at a course to be determined.
