

BYLAWS

Section 1. The Executive Committee

- a. The Executive Committee shall consist of not more than twelve (12) members and the immediate past President.
- b. The immediate past President shall be a member, ex-officio, of the Executive Committee with full voting privileges.
- c. The Secretary of the Association shall be a non-paid member of the Executive Committee.
- d. The Rating Chair shall be certified by the USGA, nominated by the President and approved by the Executive Board each year. The Rating Chair shall 1) attend meetings and seminars on course ratings as require and hold at least one educational event a year. 2) assign raters and captains to rate courses as needed (with a minimum of three seasoned raters and one novice per team), 3) maintain and update course information with the rating software, and 4) educate and develop new raters to insure consistency for the future.
- e. Each year a Nominating Committee of five members shall be formed. They shall be appointed by the Executive Board. The committee shall be comprised of one current Executive Board member, two Delegates, and two Unlimited Members. No two members of this committee may be from the same club. The Nominating Committee shall select its chairman.
- f. Election of Executive Board members shall take place at the Annual Fall meeting or thirty days following notification to the Delegates of candidate names.

Section II. Meetings

- a. The Executive Committee shall meet at the call of the President.
- b. At any meeting of the Executive Committee, the presence of one-half the number of members shall constitute a quorum.
- c. Delegates from member clubs or their appointed substitutes must be present at meetings of the Association to vote.
